To ensure the safety of everyone and to manage respiratory infections including COVID-19, we will be implementing the following:

- Parents drop-off and pick-up point will be at the front door only.
- Please be mindful of other parents during drop off & pick up and maintain a safe distance from other persons.
- Toys brought from home are not allowed at daycare at this time. Bedding will be sent home everyday for washing.
- Any signs of sickness, your child/children are to be kept at home. **PLEASE DO NOT SEND THEM TO DAYCARE.** We will have the right to refuse your child/children if they have fever, cough, sore throat, difficulty breathing and excessive runny nose. If your child presents any of the symptoms after drop off, we will call you for **IMMEDIATE PICK UP.**
- Parents need to do th health assessment to themselves and their child/ren every morning before coming to daycare,
- All children and staff are to wash their hands upon arrival at the facility.
- If the daycare is shut down due to COVID-19 reasons, **no refund** will be given to families. This also applies if a family is self-isolating for 14 days. Monthly fee will still be applied.
- A pair of inside shoes is required for every child.
